## **Prerequisites**

#### Main aim

The course is intended for the beginners to start learning written and spoken Lithuanian. The goal is to master spoken, written Lithuanian language and to gain reading, listening and speaking skills. By the end of this course students are expected to be able to communicate in Lithuanian in a broad range of everyday situations and to get acquainted with Lithuanian culture and traditions.

## **Summary**

The course is based on learning Lithuanian language: the basic words and phrases that can help to survive in everyday situations, e.g. in a shop, bus or trolleybus, students will know how to ask for way (directions), how to express gratitude, etc. The other aim of the course is to get acquainted with Lithuanian culture, to learn about cultural differences, people in Lithuania, etc.
